Sangria Blanca or white Sangria is the white version of the popular Spanish Sangria.

Sangria dates back to the 18th century and means bloodletting in Spanish.

Tinto de Verano

Originating from Spain and translates as 'red wine of summer'. This is a more popular refreshing drink that the locals drink instead of Sangria.

This drink has its origins in the early 20th century when a mix of red wine and soda was served in Cordoba. Originally called un vargas but was soon known as Tinto de Verano.
